Homelessness in North County

Homelessness is one of the biggest challenges facing San Diego and all of California as we enter 2024. Tracking the homeless population is not an easy task. Each year, the US Department of

and Housing Urban Development (HUD) requires a "point in time count" (PIT Count) of the homeless population across the United States in order to evaluate the effectiveness of local

agencies efforts

to address the burgeoning problem. In 2024, that count took place on January 25. The results of this year's PIT Count will not be available for a few months as all the data is entered and assimilated. Carlsbad has seen some positive trends in past few years' PIT Count. In 2019 161 individuals were counted (59 sheltered, 102 unsheltered). Last year, those numbers were down to 103 (43 sheltered, 60 unsheltered). However, these numbers are not reflective of the broader issue. The PIT Count can only gauge a fraction of the overall number of people experiencing homelessness. In the past, there have been claims that the true number of homeless is substantially larger than the PIT Count numbers. And any given year factors can affect the results of the count. Some factors include, how many resources are deployed to conduct the count in a given community? What was the weather the night preceding the count? In 2023 for instance, it was a particularly cold night in San Diego (37 de-





forming lives. As we celebrate our 90th year, we honor the legacy of those who came before us and pledge to continue providing transformative education and opportunities for all. Our commitment to excellence, equity, access, and inclusion remains unwavering as we look forward to shaping the future of education in our community and beyond.

MiraCosta College includes four campuses: the Oceanside Campus, the San Elijo Campus in Cardiff, the Community Learning Center, and the Technology Career Institute in Carlsbad, which reflect our mission to provide a wide array of educational pathways. Serving almost 27,000 credit, noncredit, and fee-based students annually, MiraCosta is designated a Hispanic Serving Institution (HSI) and a military-supportive institution.

MiraCosta offers associate degrees, university transfer programs, and workforce readiness certificates and is one of the original 15 California community colleges to offer a bachelor's degree.

The 90th Anniversary Celebration will showcase the completion of various con-

As we celebrate this momentous year, we reflect on our journey from humble beginnings in a wing at Oceanside High School to an educational, cultural, and community hub. We started as a "junior college" providing students opportunities to bridge high



school and university. Today, MiraCosta College's comprehensive programs and services include over 80 associate degrees and certificates, university transfer, workforce and economic development programs, and a bachelor's degree. Thoughtfully designed programs also accommodate the unique

Kindness matters

If you drove along the I-5 freeway earlier this month you might have seen a massive KINDNESS MATTERS landmark art installation---like the Hollywood sign---displayed



at **The Carlsbad Strawberry Fields**. The sign is the **Kids for Peace**'s collaborative project, part of this year's Great





trict's Building and Construction Trades students. The 8-feet tall KINDNESS letters were constructed by teacher Andie Tanner's class at **Carlsbad High School** (CHS). The 5-feet tall MATTERS letters were built by Dave Pier's students at **Aviara Oaks Middle School** (AOMS). Students worked in groups to trace the letters onto the plywood using a projector, then cut the letters out and used 2"x4"s to brace and stand them up. Next, they primed and painted the letters with a white basecoat. Finally, students representing all of Carlsbad Unified's schools gathered at the CHS gym on a Saturday to artfully de-

sign and paint the gigantic letters. Materials were donated by Logan McEniry, the owner of Oceanside Ace Hardware and a former AOMS and CHS student, and Home Depot. The Great Kindness Challenge, presented by the global nonprofit Kids for Peace, was launched in 2012 with three Carlsbad Unified schools – **Jefferson**, **Hope** and **Kelly Elementary Schools** – to address bullying and to foster connection, inclusion and compassion. The annual program has multiplied in enrollment each year. This year over 20 million students in 40,000 schools will participate, reaching across all 50 states and 115 countries.

The Carlsbad community was invited to the Carlsbad Strawberry Fields for the January 20th "grand reveal" of the Kindness Matters sign, the kick-off event for this year's **Great Kindness Challenge**. Entertainment featured a pep rally, dances by the CHS Royals and the **Sage Creek** Dance Company, and the Carlsbad High School drumline. Guests visited hands-on "Kindness Stations," where they decorated placemats for Senior Center meals and helped make a variety of other "kind" creations including bookmarks for the library, "Kindness Matters" posters, gratitude cards for service members, succulent planters, and friendship bracelets for Rafiki Amanis in Kenya.

Carlsbad Unified students participated in the 13th annual Great Kindness Challenge during the week of January 22-26, decorating their campuses and holding special "kind" community-building activities. They performed intentional acts of kindness such as helping their custodians, reading to younger students, inviting new friends to sit with them at lunch, and thanking their of-fice staff members.

Carlsbad Unified is proud to be the founding school district of The Great Kindness Challenge. We strive to educate caring, thoughtful, and compassionate young people all year long, and we believe that practicing kindness in our schools translates into a kinder world.

Kindness Matters!

Are ice baths really that good for you?

Learn the benefits and risks before trying

Ice baths are growing in popularity. They can help with post-workout recovery, reduce muscle soreness and promote overall



well-being. But anyone who wants to try this at home or elsewhere should understand what a cold-water dip or bath does to the body and weigh the benefits and risks and the importance of safety. Ice baths involve

one's

body or specific body parts in icy water, typically in temperatures ranging from 50 to 59 degrees, for a brief period.

immersing

The practice of cold-water therapy dates back many centuries. Their resurgence in popularity can be attributed to endorsements by professional athletes and celebrities.

Pro athletes use ice baths to aid in their recovery after intense workouts or competition. Others tout ice baths for other potential benefits, including mental and immune health and chronic pain relief.

So, are ice baths good for everyone?

While ice baths can help with post-workout recovery, they are not a one-size-fits-all solution. Their overall benefits are still being studied. In general, they are not harmful, but they are not meant for everyone.

"People with pre-existing health conditions, such as diabetes or heart issues, should check with their doctor before attempting ice baths to ensure their safety," says Alex Crane, MD, a family medicine physician with expertise in sports medicine and injury treatment at **Scripps** Clinic Del Mar.



While ice baths can help with post-workout recovery, they are not a one-size-fits-all solution.

What are the benefits of ice baths?

Ice baths offer both proven and potential benefits, including:

Relieves sore muscles

Ice baths, or cold-water immersion, promote faster recovery from sore muscles and reduced muscle fatigue after intense exercise. The icy water can help flush out metabolic waste products and decrease muscle soreness after intense workouts. This then leads to reduced muscle soreness and increased post-exercise comfort.

Reduces inflammation

The cold temperature of ice baths causes blood vessels to constrict, which can help decrease swelling and inflammation in the muscles and joints. This is especially beneficial for athletes looking to expedite the healing of minor injuries or strains.

Improves mood

Ice baths are believed to stimulate the release of mood-lifting brain chemicals. This natural mood lift contributes to an enhanced sense of well-being and relaxation.

Arthritis management

People with arthritis may find relief through cold water immersion. It can help alleviate joint pain and reduce inflammation, providing temporary respite from the discomfort associated with this condition.

What are risks and side effects?

While ice baths offer potential benefits, they also come with risks and side effects, including:

Hypothermia

Prolonged exposure to chilly water can lead to hypothermia, a dangerous drop in core body temperature. This risk highlights the importance of sticking to recommended immersion times and temperatures.

Keep in mind, older adults are more sensitive to cold than younger adults.

Cold shock response

Sudden immersion in icy water can shock the body. This can result in rapidly increased breathing, heart rate and blood pressure. The initial shock of the cold can also be dangerous as it can increase the risk of drowning if you're in deep water.

Cardiovascular stress

Ice baths can put stress on the cardiovascular system. They may not be suitable for people with certain heart conditions.

Caution taking ice baths at home

Ice baths can be done at home or in a chilly lake or at places that offer cold-water therapy supervised by trained professionals.

If you want to try this at home in the safest way possible, check first with your doctor, especially if you have an injury or health condition. There are no official recommendations for taking an ice bath but studies suggest that staying in cold water for 5 to 15 minutes offers results.

At home, you'll need a bathtub or an immersion tub, cold water, ice, a thermometer to monitor water temperature and a timer. Staying in the tub can be difficult so start small with 2 to 5 minutes and slowly increase your time in an ice bath.

Make sure to have warm towels and clothes ready when you emerge. Proper equipment and caution ensures a safe and effective experience.

It's crucial to pay close attention to your body's response during an ice bath. "If you experience excessive discomfort, numbness or any adverse reactions, exit the bath promptly," Dr. Crane says. "Safety should always be the top priority."

Alternatives to ice baths

It's important to note that ice baths are not the only option for post-workout recovery. So before starting any new recovery method, including ice baths, contrast baths or compression therapy, consult with your doctor.

"What works best for you may depend on your fitness level, health status and personal preferences," Dr. Crane says.

As an initial photographer for revolutionary rock music publication Rolling Stone, Baron Wolman captured naturalistic portraits of the period's rising icons, including Jimi Hendrix, Joni Mitchell, BB King, Joan Baez, The Grateful Dead, and more. Baron's proximity to the artists combined with his unique photojournalistic approach resulted in captivating images documenting performing artists, as well as intimate portraits which illuminated their personal lives off stage. Curated by the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, this special exhibition presents photographs from four areas of Baron Wolman's Rolling Stone period, including California Rock, Women of Rock, Icons of R&B, and Classic Rock. "Access is the key to making

grees). That factor alone could have altered the unsheltered population.

The City of Carlsbad has established a 5-year strategic plan to address homelessness in Carlsbad.

The plan has four strategies:

(1) Expand the city's capacity to prevent and reduce homelessness;

(2) Coordinate, collaborate and support local efforts and organizations working to address homelessness in Carlsbad;

(3) Retain, protect and increase the supply of housing and other affordable living options in Carlsbad;

(4) Be active in external policy issues.

Last year Carlsbad put some action behind this plan as it approved **Catholic Charity**'s expansion of **La Posada de Guadalupe** homeless shelter. La Posada is the city's only homeless shelter. La Posada was founded in 1992 to shelter migrant farmworkers.

Currently La Posada has 50 beds and is for men only. The \$2 million grant that was approved came through the County of San Diego and will allow them to build a second floor with 30-50 additional beds for women and children.

There are many agencies doing good work in this space here in North County. Some of them include **Operation Hope**, **Community Resource Center**, **Interfaith Community Services** and more.

Another service provider who is doing some great work is Solutions for Change. Solutions for Change focuses specifically on family homelessness. Their mission is to address the root causes that land families in these difficult situations. Last year, Solutions celebrated 20 years of ministry and has helped transform the lives of 1,300 families, including 2,800 children. One of the most impressive statistics at Solutions for Change is their ability to reunite children, who have been removed from the home by Social Services and placed in Foster Care, with their parents. To date Solutions boasts a 100% reunification rate. Solutions for Change relies entirely on corporate and private donors to fund their operations due to their accountability model that requires those in their program to be alcohol/drug free. While this accountability model is part of their secret sauce at Solutions, it has precluded them from receiving any government funding since 2016 as the government requires those receiving public dollars to accept active drug users into their programs (a policy known as Housing First).

Despite these challenges, Solutions for Change continues to battle the cyclical churn that lands so many into homelessness. In 2023 Solutions for Change was named the **CBAD Awards People's Choice** Winner. Congratulations to Solutions for Change. Thank you for your ministry.


