Women take the reins

With International Women's Day being March 8, we thought it would be interesting to look at some prominent female leaders

that have made an impact in the Carlsbad Chamber over the past 101 years. The Carlsbad Chamber of Commerce was founded in 1923, however, the first female Pres-

ident of our organization was not until 1957. In 1957 and 1958 Miss A. Stephens Lowrie was the President of the Board. I was not able to find out much about her, but she remained the sole female leader on record for 20 more years. In 1976 Zetta Castle became the President of the Board. Zetta had a reputation as an exceptional artist here in Carlsbad.

Margaret Stanton may be one of the most noteworthy Board Chairs. She served as President in 1990 and again in 1998. She was the CFO at Jazzercise here in Carlsbad. She also became a City Council representative. One of her lasting claims to fame is that as she exited public office in 1998, she coaxed Matt Hall to run for office. That propelled him to run for City Council, which he first won in 1998. He served in that capacity for many years before becoming a threeterm Mayor here in Carlsbad. Thank you, Margaret for your service and for giving Matt a nudge.

Elaine Lyttleton was another mover and shaker on the Carlsbad Chamber Board.

She served as Board Chair in 1993.

In this vein, we are proud to have **Hera Hub** in Carlsbad. Hera Hub is a fe-





male-focused coworking space and business accelerator that provides education, mentoring, and collaboration for women entrepreneurs to help their businesses grow and thrive.



Small business tours start in Carlsbad Village

The City of Carlsbad has launched a series of business tours to help understand the needs of businesses and work to support a thriving economy. Last month, the **Carlsbad Village Association** (CVA) partnered



with the Innovation & Economic Development Department to kick off this series with a twoand-a-half-hour tour of small businesses in the Village. Mayor Keith Blackburn and Councilmember Melanie Burkholder were joined by David Graham who leads the depart-

ment as the Chief Innovation Officer and Matt Sanford the Economic Development Manager. February's visit, the first of many to come, was designed to bring to light both the successes and the challenges of four businesses that CVA chose to help illustrate a variety of business models.

"Carlsbad is not just business-friendly; we are business-forward," David explained. "Meeting with our local companies in-person helps us anticipate needs and work proactively to support the small business engine of our economy."

Miriah LeClerc, owner of Revolution Roasters, shared her professional journey and desire for a community-focused business at The Cottages in Carlsbad. Open just half a year, and not yet having experienced a summer downtown when foot traffic increases with out-of-town visitors, she said she is heartened by how quickly her coffee house was embraced by the community and is optimistic about the future. Howev-

er, work force attraction and retention are a concern for Miriah. With her first location in Oceanside, now 10 years old, she can share some staffing between the two businesses, but finding people with the skills and availability needed, who want to grow with her business, will remain a challenge.

Bryan Tracey, owner of Status Skateshop, shared his business vision and the path he took to get where he is. He also shared some of the difficulties he has had regarding building signage and an interpretation of accepted uses within the Village and Barrio Master Plan for desired expansion.

"I wasn't sure what to expect with the business visit and was pleasantly surprised by what appeared to be completely earnest interest, curiosity and support," said Bryan. "I am so glad we were able to be a part of it."

Chris Slowey, co-owner of Shoots Fish & Beer, shared his positive experience with the permitting and build-out process for The Cottages, and Carrie Moore, owner of Trove Marketplace, discussed the need for employee and/or short-term parking to help increase parking turnover downtown.

"As we walked from a craft coffee house that makes everything from scratch to a hangout for world-class surfers, to an international hub for skateboarders, I felt a deep connection with these business owners," Councilmember Burkholder said. "Every day they are contributing, not just to our dynamic economy, but to the Carlsbad community. U.S. Small Business Administration Office of Advocacy states, "There are 33.3 million small businesses across the country, employing more than 61.6 million people, as of 2023; 89% have fewer than 20 employees."

As a small business owner, I have an affinity for the people behind the businesses who are driving our economy, and I want to say thank you for your dedication."

The city has strategically placed their support as one of the four key pillars of the city's Economic Development Strategic Plan, which is just now starting the second year of its five-year plan. Part of the plan includes providing additional resources to small businesses through the city's Job-Readiness Room, the cybersecurity awareness program, Life in Action, Innovate 78, and other support programs.

CVA was honored to help kick off the small business tours in downtown Carlsbad. Due to the desire of both city staff and council to meet and learn from more small businesses, a second tour is already on the calendar this month, and more are planned throughout the city.

New CSUSM program opens doors for students with intellectual disabilities

Rebecca Brooks arrived at Cal State San Marcos with 16 years of experience as a special education teacher - and with a dream. Almost since the day she was hired as a



professor in the School of Education in 2015, Brooks has aspired to establish a program that would give students with intellectual disabilities as close to a normal college experience as possible. A couple of years

into her tenure, she began talking to

CSUSM colleagues about it. In 2020, during a sabbatical, she started working on it. And now, nearly a decade later, that dream is a reality.

Last fall, Brooks officially established the Aspiring Scholars program, a four-year initiative for students with intellectual disabilities who aren't pursuing a degree but are seeking an inclusive college experience. Four students are part of the first cohort of this program in which they learn and grow alongside the CSUSM community while earning a certificate in higher education career studies and skill development.

"I'm thrilled that we are able to offer this program at CSUSM," Brooks said. "It's something that I've wanted even prior to working at CSUSM. So being able to create a pathway for students when they finish high school to attend a four-year university is very exciting and much needed."

Aspiring Scholars falls into the category of a nationwide trend called Inclusive Postsecondary Education (IPSE), which is designed for students with intellectual disabilities (and of college age) to continue academic, career and technical, and independent living instruction to prepare themselves for employment. CSUSM has joined more than 300 degree-granting institutions in the United States that offer IPSE programs, which

might sound impressive until you consider that the country contains more than 4,300 such institutions.

In California, the ratio is even more dire, as only five four-year universities in the state offered IPSE programs in 2022. Brooks is trying to help change that, and the state grant that's funding her program involves a partnership with five other California State University campuses: East Bay, Long Beach, Northridge, San Francisco and San Jose.

Brooks pointed to data showing that only 3% of adults with intellectual disabilities make a living wage in California, whereas a survey by Think College – a national research center based at UMass Boston for students with intellectual disabilities - found that 73% of respondents had a paid job one year after completing an IPSE.

"It is critical that more programs like this be developed and offered to students," Brooks said.

The four students in the inaugural cohort - Joshua Corder, Roman Martens, Tammy Tang and Alex Vaghefi – are participants in a program that has been tailored to their individual needs. Guided by peer mentors, students are required to take at least two classes per semester, but they can choose any discipline they want based on their interests and career goals. In Year 2, an internship component will be introduced to offer the students an opportunity to gain skills and experiences. And Aspiring Scholars provides plenty of chances for students to get involved in campus life, whether it's clubs, university events or sports competitions.

Brooks said the first year of Aspiring Scholars has exceeded her expectations, in large part because of the support she has received from faculty and staff across campus. She anticipates that the number of students will remain at roughly the same level for Year 2, but she plans to apply for additional funding that will allow the program to build on itself and become more sustainable.

"I'm excited to see it grow," she said.

Heart disease kills more women than all forms of cancer combined. However, only about half of American women are aware that heart disease is their greatest health threat. "Even when

women do have warning signs of a heart attack, they

often are very different than the symptoms men experience," says Poulina Uddin, MD, a cardiologist with Scripps Women's Heart Center. "Both men and women may feel chest pain or break out in a cold sweat during a heart attack, but that is where most of the similarities end."

HEART ATTACK SYMPTOMS IN WOMEN

Women tend to have subtler symptoms, and they may begin up to a month before the heart attack. Symptoms may include:

- Shortness of breath
- Unusual sweating, nausea or vomiting
- ${\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$ Pain that spreads to the upper body,
- neck or jawPressure, or tightness in the center of the chest
- Indigestion, heartburn
- Sudden dizziness
- Fatigue or weakness



Heart disease is the greatest health threat to American women.

- Unusual tiredness
- Problems sleeping

Women may not take these symptoms seriously because they can resemble common illnesses such as the flu. This assumption can be a serious mistake, and it could even be fatal.

If you experience these symptoms, don't ignore them. Play it safe and call 911. Taking immediate action can save your life.

Don't drive yourself or let a friend drive you to the hospital. Paramedics can provide medical assistance while taking you to an emergency room. Remember, the sooner you get treatment, the greater the chances of recovery.

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Even if you think your heart is healthy, get screened for heart disease, especially if you have a family history of heart problems, high blood pressure, high cholesterol or diabetes. The more risk factors you have, the higher your risk of heart disease.

"Women also have risk factors that don't affect men, such as developing diabetes or high blood pressure during pregnancy," says Dr. Uddin. "Also, hormones, such as estrogen, may play a role in protecting women from heart disease; after menopause, that protection disappears."

Make an appointment with your physician to discuss your heart health and establish a baseline. Learn to adopt a hearthealthy lifestyle now and minimize your risk of problems in the future.

RISK FACTORS FOR HEART DISEASE YOU CAN'T CONTROL

There are many risk factors that you can't control, including:

AGE AND MENOPAUSE

Women tend to develop heart disease around 10 years later than men. This is because women produce estrogen, a hormone that offers some defense against heart disease prior to the onset of menopause.

FAMILY HISTORY

A family history of heart disease can raise your risk of heart disease. It may be because your family carries genes that raise your risk.

PREGNANCY HISTORY

High blood pressure, diabetes, and preeclampsia during pregnancy can increase your chances of developing heart disease later in life.

RACE AND ETHNICITY

African Americans are at higher risk of heart disease due to factors like high blood pressure, obesity, and diabetes. Black Americans, especially women, may also be less likely than others to receive preventive treatment, including medicines to lower blood pressure.

RISK FACTORS YOU CAN CONTROL

There are many risk factors that you can control, including:

- Quit smoking. Smoking causes heart disease and can even be more dangerous for women than men.
- Eat healthy, which can prevent problems that lead to heart disease, including high blood pressure or obesity.
- Limit how much alcohol you drink.
- Exercise regularly. Physical activity can also prevent high blood pressure, obesity and diabetes.
- Manage stress in healthy ways.
- Get an annual physical exam.










City of Carlsbad opens the 2024-25 community arts grants period

Importantly, by fostering the work of local and regional arts organizations, the city





Robert L. Watson



Robert L. Watson July 1, 1925 - January 22, 2024

Robert L. Watson was born in Lynn, MA. At 18 years old and with the onset of WW2, he enlisted in the Navy and was assigned to the 6th Beach Battalion. His battalion orders were to invade the shores of France on D-Day, June 6, 1944. Assigned with the Beach Masters, his Unit was the first to land on Normandy, Omaha Beach. His landing craft, while approaching the beach, hit a mine, and exploded. He sus-

tained wounds that earned him a Purple Heart. His unit experienced heavy losses and spent 28 days In Loving securing the French Coast. As a result of Robert's efforts, he was promoted three times during the campaign and was decorated with numerous service medals, including the "Croix de Guerre with Palm Leaf" from France. Near the end of WW2, he was reassigned to Camp Pendleton, CA, to serve out the rest of his duties in the Navy. It was at that time, at the USO in downtown Oceanside, that he met the love of his life, Marjorie. Robert, along with his new wife, settled in Carlsbad, CA, where he started his new business, RLW Construction, responsible for building hundreds of homes in North County from the 1950s to

the 1970s. He is also remembered for building and opening the Wayside Inn Restaurant in Carlsbad. As a civic leader throughout his life, he served as President of the Carlsbad Community Chest, the Carlsbad Boys Club, and the Lions Club. He was also a member of the Carlsbad School Board and was named Carlsbad Chamber of Commerce "Man of the Year" in 1960.

He is survived Marjorie, bv all three boys, their spousgrandes, children, and great-grandchildren. In his retirement, he dedicated his life to educating civic groups and schools about the reality of war and the importance

of remembering the men and women who gave their lives for our county. Robert also volunteered on the Midway Aircraft Carrier in San Diego, sharing his experiences during WW2 with the public. He enjoyed playing golf with his buddies and motor-homing with his wife and friends around the world. He lived a long and wonderful life, and we will miss him dearly.






