## Compassionate care in life's final chapter



When Kathie Jackson, a Registered Nurse, founded Hospice By The Sea in 1994, she had a clear mission: to create an organization where personalized, patient-centered care was the top priority. More than 30 years later, that commitment remains stronger

"When I worked as a hospice nurse before starting Hospice By The Sea, I was always aware of the limitations we faced," Jackson recalls. "Unless a patient had an acute issue, the care we could provide was restricted. While patients and families were grateful, I constantly wished we could do more."

That desire to offer more comprehensive, compassionate care became the foundation of Hospice By The Sea. Today, the Solana Beach-based organization continues

to serve patients across North County with a multidisciplinary team of registered nurses, licensed vocational nurses, home health aides, social workers, spiritual counselors, and dedicated volunteers. Their shared goal is to provide comfort, dignity, and support to both patients and their loved ones during life's final chapter.

#### **HOSPICE CARE:** WHAT IT IS AND WHAT IT ISN'T

Many people mistakenly believe that hospice care is synonymous with giving up, but this is far from the truth.

"One common misconception is that choosing hospice means you've surrendered to your diagnosis," says Jackson. "But it's not about giving up—it's about shifting the focus to comfort and quality of life. Hospice care doesn't mean all treatments stop. Patients may still receive antibiotics, breathing treatments, or other symptom management interventions. In fact, once the emotional and physical stress of aggressive treatments subsides, some patients actually improve and 'graduate' from hospice."

Hospice care is fully covered by Medicare, Medi-Cal, and most private insurance plans, meaning patients and their families are never billed for services, medications, or co-pays by Hospice By The Sea. To qualify, individuals must have a chronic long-term illness certified by their attending physician, with a prognosis of six months or less. However, there is no strict time limit on how long someone can remain in hospice. Patients are initially certified for two 90-day periods,



followed by an unlimited number of 60-day recertification periods. As long as the patient's condition continues to decline, they remain eligible. Conversely, if their condition improves, they can choose to revoke hospice care and resume curative treatment, if desired.

#### **EMPOWERING PATIENTS** WITH CHOICE

At its core, Hospice By The Sea is committed to honoring the wishes of its patients even when it comes to how they choose to die. The agency supports California's End of Life Option Act (EOLOA), which was enacted in 2016. This law gives terminally ill patients the legal right to pursue Medical Aid in Dying (MAiD)—a process by which they voluntarily ingest medication to end their life peacefully and on their own terms. Hospice By The Sea stands by its patients throughout this deeply personal decision. The agency offers emotional and practical support by providing a nurse or volunteer death doula to be present during the ingestion, offering reassurance and comfort to both the patient and their loved ones

Remember when the chore of bringing reusable bags into the grocery store was almost unbearable? How many times did

we get to the front doors only to realize that we had to turn around and go back to our car for our bags? Now, however, it is an ingrained reaction to grab our reusable bags from the back seat before walking inside, and maybe even pick out a favorite or two. We no longer

forget; it has become a habit.

The **Carlsbad Village Association** (CVA) continues to build its sustainability muscle memory downtown in everything it does. From meetings to events and working with the State Street Farmers Market vendors and businesses to make the transition from single-use plastics a reality, we are committed to this process.

After the first Taste of Carlsbad Village in 2017, it became obvious to us that we needed to be more environmentally friendly. We implemented changes for our future events, even before it was a requirement, and swapped out thousands of plastic glasses and forks for single-use stainless steel keepsake glasses and sporks. We also provided every restaurant with compostable serveware, to replace any plastic ware, and worked with the city's sustainability contractor ReEarth Consultants, to capture compost waste and take it to the closest facility at the time in Los Angeles. Since then, having high

environmental ethics has been a cornerstone of the Carlsbad Village Association.

In January of 2024, CVA entered a Pilot Program with the City's Sustainability Management Materials Division to bring its 65 vendors at the State Street Farmers Market into compliance with the state's Single Use Plastics Ban and SB1383 regulations regarding organic waste collection and disposal. What started as a rigorous education period with many questions has turned into a habit as well.

Farmers market vendors now use either paper bags or reusable bags in lieu of single-use plastic bags. Many have upgraded their packaging to be more environmentally friendly and compliant. Some farmers and artisan vendors are now using BPI-certified compostable bags for their produce that CVA supplies to them through a cooperative program with Los Angeles-based

BioBagUSA. CVA purchases cases of approved products and warehouses them and then sells them back to the market vendors at cost to help them remain in compliance. And, of course, with the focus on reusable bags, CVA has handed out over 10,000 tote bags at the farmers market through the years, to be good stewards of the community.

Sourcing BPI-certified compostable serve ware continues to pose a challenge for our vendors who serve hot food to go at the market. It is our hope that as the single-use plastics ban becomes more widespread, cost-effective and locally sourced products will be available to our vendors to further help with this mandate.

What once was a chore is now becoming a habit. The Carlsbad Village Association is proud to be doing its part daily in downtown Carlsbad.



ages. Our Community Education and Workforce Development programs play a crucial role in aligning education with industry demands, ensuring individuals and businesses can thrive in a rapidly changing world.

A key part of our workforce training initiatives is the Technology Career Institute (TCI) in Carlsbad, which exemplifies how education can meet the needs of local industries. Founded in 2013 and opening its doors in 2015, TCI offers hands-on, accelerated training in fields where employers face skill gaps. From electronics and robotics to

manufacturing and HVAC, TCI works closely with local businesses to develop programs tailored to the specific skills they require. One of the newest additions to TCI's offerings is the Biomedical Device Technician Program, which addresses the growing need for highly skilled technicians in the booming medical device industry. This program equips students with the skills required to maintain and repair medical devices, ensuring they are prepared to meet the demands of healthcare providers and manufacturers alike.

By collaborating with local employers, such as Creative Electron in San Marcos, we are able to design programs that equip students with the most in-demand skills. This partnership has been highly successful, with over 60% of Creative Electron's hires being job-ready TCl graduates who have applied

real-world skills during their training. The result is a reliable pipeline of qualified candidates for local businesses.

TCl's immersive programs teach technical skills and develop critical soft skills like problem-solving, collaboration, and communication—skills employers highly value. Classes are structured to mirror the workplace, with students clocking in and out and receiving continuous feedback to ensure they meet industry standards. As a result, 93% of graduates secure employment after completing the program.

Thanks to generous support from organizations like the Lowe's Foundation, which donated \$500,000 in 2024 to fund new electrician and HVAC programs, TCI continues to grow and stay ahead of industry trends. Since its founding, TCI has received more than \$13 million in grants, enabling it to ex-

pand and better serve the community.

In addition to our workforce training programs, Community Education provides a wide range of non-credit courses designed to foster personal growth and enhance professional skills. These programs are available to individuals at every stage of life, offering opportunities for those looking to expand their knowledge or explore new career paths. Whether through leadership development, personal finance workshops, or digital skills training, our Community Education offerings empower learners to gain valuable skills in a supportive and flexible environment.

Building on this commitment to accessible education, we're also excited to bring back College for Kids this summer. These weeklong camps for children aged 6-16, held at our Oceanside Campus, offer a variety of fun and educational experiences—from veterinary programs and comics/cartooning to culinary classes, wilderness skills, and science experiments. With such a broad range of subjects, there's something for every young learner.

At MiraCosta College, we understand that education must be relevant, timely, and responsive to the needs of both students and employers. Our Community Education and Workforce Development programs, including TCI and the Biomedical Device Technician Program, exemplify how workforce training can drive economic growth, create opportunities, and meet the needs of local businesses.

## Leading the way in sustainable building design



**Kaiser Permanente** has long been a pioneer in healthcare, not just in terms of patient care but also in its commitment to sustainability. The San Diego and San Marcos Medical Centers stand as a testament to this dedication, showcasing innovative design and environmental stewardship.

These medical centers, designed by CO Architects and constructed by Hensel Phelps, are shining examples of sustainable building practices. They have achieved Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Platinum certification, the highest level of recognition from the U.S. Green Building Council. This certification proves the building's efficiency in energy, water conservation, and the use of sustainable materials.

One of the standout features of our medical centers is their approach to energy efficiency. The building incorporates advanced systems that reduce energy consumption, including high-performance glazing, energy-efficient lighting, and a state-of-the-art heating, ventilation, and air conditioning system. These features not only reduce the building's carbon footprint but also result in significant cost savings.

Water conservation is another critical aspect of these facilities' design. By using low-flow fixtures and a sophisticated irrigation system, water usage is reduced dramatically. The landscaping also features drought-tolerant plants, further minimizing water consumption.

The use of sustainable materials is evident throughout these medical centers. From recycled steel to paints designed to emit fewer volatile, organic compounds, every aspect of construction was carefully considered to minimize environmental impact. This commitment to sustainability extends to the interior design, with furniture and finishes chosen for their eco-friendly attributes.

Climate change affects the environment and the health of our members and communities. Kaiser Permanente has been working for decades to improve the health of both. Starting in the 1950s with air pollution control equipment at the Kaiser Steel Mill, we have continually advanced our sustainability efforts, including forming an Ecology Committee in the 1970s and pioneering solar power for health facilities in the 1980s. Recognized for green practices since 2002, we introduced the first farmers market at a U.S. hospital in 2003 and made significant solar investments in 2010. By 2020, we achieved carbon neutrality and reduced our greenhouse gas emissions by 30% from 2008 levels. In 2022, we joined the U.S. Health and

Human Services climate pledge, aiming to reduce emissions by 50% by 2030 and reach net-zero emissions by 2050.

"Achieving double Platinum LEED certi-

fication on the San Diego Medical Center, with both Building Design and Construction and Operations and Maintenance Platinum ratings, is a testament to our unwavering commitment to sustainability and environmental stewardship," said Brian McCowan, Kaiser Permanente San Diego Medical Center's facilities operations director. "It reflects our dedication to creating healthier, more efficient, sustainable spaces for our community. We continue to reinforce our commitment to this strategy by building the San Marcos Medical Center to exacting LEED Platinum standards on our campus there."

Both San Diego and San Marcos Medical Centers are not just places for healing; they are models for sustainable healthcare facilities worldwide. By prioritizing environmental stewardship, we are setting a new standard for the healthcare industry, demonstrating that it is possible to provide top-notch patient care while also protecting

## Ensuring reliability despite climate challenges

For more than 80 years, the **Water Authority** and its 22 member agencies have worked together to deliver safe and reliable water to sustain our economy – from biotech and farming to tourism and outdoor sports.

Despite climate challenges and a limited local water supply, strategic investments ensure that water continues flowing to support our homes, businesses, and economy.

What most people don't know is where that water comes from. The region relies on a diversified water supply to ensure long-term reliability. The majority—about 61%—comes from the Colorado River, secured through conservation efforts in the Imperial Valley, where water savings from farms and canals are transferred to San Diego.

Local supplies, including seawater desalination, recycled water, water purification, and brackish groundwater, make up 33% of the region's water. The remaining 6% comes from the State Water Project, which transports water from Northern California's Bay-Delta through an extensive delivery system managed by the California Department of Water Resources.

Water can travel up to 1,000 miles before reaching local taps. Snowmelt from the Rocky Mountains feeds the Colorado River, while Northern California water moves through the State Water Project. With 1,600 structures and over 100 flow control facilities, the Water Authority's countywide infrastructure is vital to provide San Diego with a safe and reliable source of water.

Maintaining this complex system comes at a cost, and as with many essential services across the state, those costs are rising. There are a variety of reasons for this, including inflation that is driving up the cost of items

like electricity, steel and chemicals needed for water delivery and treatment.

The Water Authority and its member agencies are not immune from those impacts. In fact, San Diego County's

strategic investments in supply reliability, coupled with the work to maintain the aqueduct system, means upward pressure on water rates will continue – just like it will for almost everything else.

The good news is that even during long dry spells, the Water Authority can meet the regional demand for water that sustains our economy and quality of life.





Thanks to decades of strategic planning we ensure the water keeps flowing, despite climate challenges and limited local water supplies. From supporting biotech breakthroughs to sustaining world-class resorts, a safe and reliable water supply keeps Carlsbad thriving.
















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
