However, that drive and innovation were still very active here. So instead of attracting professors and college students, we switched our attention to LEGO Masters and tourists.

As the 1980's transitioned into the 1990's, the LEGO Corporation was scouring the land of the free and the home of the brave for the perfect spot for its first North American theme park. They evaluated thousands of potential sites. By 1993, they had narrowed their options down to two sites: Carlsbad and an eastcoast location. At that time, Elaine Lyttleton was the Chairman of the Board for

the Carlsbad Chamber of Commerce. Elaine led a delegation of city, civic, business and community leaders to Denmark to convince the LEGO Corporation that Carlsbad was the perfect spot. And she succeeded.

The next year, she had to convince Carlsbad residents of the same thing. Looking back on it today you might think, "well that must have been a no-brainer!" But it wasn't as easy as you would think. There were wild allegations in certain pockets of the community that a theme park like this would bring all kinds of debauchery to our beloved community. Some even claimed it would be a beacon for prostitution. Luckily, those voices were not heeded in a significant way and the referendum to support LEGOLAND coming to Carlsbad passed. LEGOLAND California opened its doors in 1999 and the positive economic effect that LEGOLAND has had on Carlsbad cannot be overestimated. Since LEGOLAND opened its doors, 1.5 hotels/year have been built in the area surrounding our beloved theme park. The vast majority of those ho-

tels have been built right here in Carlsbad – and of course, there has been overflow into Oceanside, Encinitas and Vista as well. Carlsbad is now home to 46 hotels and over 5,000 rooms. This fiscal year the city of Carlsbad will receive over \$38M in TOT revenue. TOT stands for Tourist Occupancy Tax. Only one city in San Diego County generates more TOT revenue each year than Carlsbad and that is San Diego itself. LEGOLAND has two hotels on its own property and has its eyes on a third, but they have become a beacon for hoteliers looking for a profitable place to expand.

In addition to both directly and indirectly generating revenue for the city of Carlsbad,

LEGOLAND is the ultimate workforce development site. Each summer they employ close to 2,000 young people as they provide a great experience for all the young families that visit our fair town. For many of those youthful workers, it is their first real job. This is a great resource and asset to our business community.



Student-led sustainability at Carlsbad High Schools

The Lifestyle Magazine Club at Pacific Ridge School interviewed local high schools leaders about their efforts to increase sustainability in Carlsbad school communities through student-led sustainability clubs.



Q&A with Bella Lipsey and Makena Hamilton, presidents of Carlsbad High School's Green Club

Q: What is the main goal of the Green Club at CHS?

A: We invite people to learn not just about the basics of sustainability and environmentalism, but also how to integrate changes to create more sustainable lifestyles.

Q: How has the green club enacted change in your community?

A: We're working on a project with our PTSA to beautify our library in a cost and eco-friendly manner. This will create a space for students to gather during breaks to eat, work, and hang out with friends. We've participated in various trail and beach cleanups and created recycled toys for sheltered dogs.

Q: What do you think about sustainability on your campus?

A: There've been some efforts to be more sustainable on campus specifically aimed at reducing food waste through the addition of various waste bins. However, there is room to improve and grow the limits to which our campus can be environmentally friendly.

Q: What do you think students at CHS think about sustainability?

A: I think students are split on the topic, however, those who are interested and care about sustainability are so passionate and determined that it makes up for it. We have a large network of students who are members of not only the Green Club but also clean-up clubs around our campus and community.

Q&A with Dahlia Nichols, president of Sage Creek High School's Environmental Club

Q: What is the goal of the Environmental Club at SGHS?

A: We foster a connection with the school to promote education about and love for the environment. We also talk about issues facing the environment, and we promote cooperation to conserve it.

Q: How has the green club enacted change in your school community?

about issues, such as the Willow Project, an oil drilling project in Alaska, to educate students about environmental problems. We also provide community service opportunities through outside organizations.







What to do, and not do in case of a snake bite

DO NOT WAIT FOR SYMPTOMS TO APPEAR, CALL 911

Don't let fear of snakes stop you and your family from hiking or biking the trails as the days heat up and sunlight lingers.



While you should stay away from venomous snakes, you are more likely to die from a lightning strike than from a snakebite. Of the 7,000 to 8,000 people in the United States bitten annually by venomous snakes approximately five die, according to the Centers

for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).

The number of deaths from a venomous snake bite would be much higher if people did not seek medical care, according to the CDC.

To stay safe, arm yourself with prevention and protection tips.

"Educate yourself, be smart and make good choices, but understand that you are pretty unlikely to be harmed by a snake," says Christen Benke, DO, a family medicine physician at Scripps Clinic Del Mar. "If you do get bit, hospitals are well-equipped with antivenom procedures. Snake bites rarely result in fatalities, especially if you know how to respond."

SYMPTOMS OF VENOMOUS SNAKEBITE

Snakes are most active during warmer months. In San Diego County, snake season typically spans from spring through fall.

If you are bit by a snake, stay calm and act quickly. Severe pain, swelling and color change at the site and lightheadedness are symptoms of a poisonous bite.

OTHER SYMPTOMS INCLUDE:

- Puncture marks at wound site
- Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea
- Labored breathing
- Rapid heart rate, weak pulse, low blood pressure
- Disturbed vision
- Metallic, mint or rubber taste in the mouth
- Increased salivation and sweating
- Numbness or tingling around face
- and/or limbs
- Muscle twitching

CALL 911 IMMEDIATELY

If you are bitten, call 911 to get medical attention as soon as possible. If you have to find a phone, stay calm and walk at a relaxed pace.

"Your goal is to get to a hospital as soon as possible to be assessed for possible antivenom treatment," says Dr. Benke. "For best results, antivenom treatment should be given as soon as possible after the bite. It is usually given within four hours of a bite."



Don't wait for symptoms to appear if you are bitten by a snake, call 911.

WHILE WAITING FOR EMERGENCY HELP TO ARRIVE:

• Lay or sit down with the bite in a neutral position of comfort.

- Wash the bite with soap and water.
- Cover the bit with a clean, dry dressing.Remove any jewelry or tight-fitting
- clothing in case of swelling.Keep affected area below heart level if possible to keep venom from spreading.

WHAT NOT TO DO:

- Do not pick up the snake or try to trap it.Do not wait for symptoms to appear if
- bitten; get medical help right away.Don't apply a tourniquet. This may cut off blood flow to the affected area.
- Don't pack the bite area in ice.
- Don't cut the wound with a knife or razor. Making an incision may damage internal body structures.
- Don't use your mouth to suck out the venom.
- Don't drink alcohol, caffeine or take any medication.
- Don't use a snakebite kit. Commercial kits often contain a blade for making an incision, which may damage internal body structures. The kits sometimes also include suction devices, which are ineffective at removing venom.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR:

It's important to know the types of snakes you might encounter on certain trails or walking the golf course. In Southern California, the most common venomous snake you are likely to stumble upon is the rattlesnake.

"Rattlesnakes are a fact of life in Southern California," says Dr. Benke. "Be informed and then go outside and enjoy the warm weather." they usually release as much venom as they can to protect themselves.

HOW TO PREVENT SNAKE BITES

Taking a few precautions and staying aware of your surroundings can go a long way toward preventing a trip to the emergency room.

PROTECT YOUR SKIN

Hide your ankles and wear sturdy shoes. High ankle socks will help protect your ankles from unexpected snakebites while hiking or running.

TAKE NOTICE OF WARNING SIGNS

Heed the warning signs of snakes in an area. Always stay on the trail. Crevices between rocks, tall thick grass and mossy areas near waterfalls or rivers are favorite hangouts for snakes.

BE CAREFUL WHERE YOU STEP

Pay attention. Watch where you plant your feet. You don't want to frighten a sun-bathing snake in the middle of the trail or golf course.

DON'T PANIC

If you see a snake, don't panic. Slowly back away from the snake and either try to find a way around or go back the way you came. Snakes tend not to harm people unless they are provoked. Respect their space, and they will respect yours. Never taunt a snake.

CARRY YOUR CELL PHONE


Carry your cell phone, especially if you're going to be out alone in an area where snakes are active. Better yet, go with someone if possible. If you do get bit, having someone to assist you will be helpful.

CALL ANIMAL CONTROL IF SNAKE ON PROPERTY

If you live in San Diego County and need to remove a snake from your property, call Animal Services at 619-236-2341.

AVOID NIGHTTIME TRAIL WALKS

Snakes can be active during the day, but are also nocturnal since they have to remain in motion on cold nights to maintain their body temperature. Snakes also hunt at night since their heat sensors allow them to detect prey unseen. It's too easy to miss seeing a snake in the dark.



Who are your (financial) friends?

Do you know the difference between a friend and an acquaintance? A friend tells you the truth even when you don't want to hear it. Consider me a friend in any scenario, especially for your finances.



I'm Justin Peek, of **PEEK WEALTH**, and I'm going to share some truths I've researched in 19 years of financial advising that will benefit you We immediately. started this back in January with, Your life is not a rehearsal—are you paying

attention?. (Sidenote, I reopened the free book download at www.peekwealth.com/ enough.)

Like my eleven-year-old daughter with her Scuba lesson last week, let's dive in! We're going to fill in a few common gaps I see between your ears, between you and whatever media you consume, and in how you may be incorrectly defining risk.

Let's start with your brain. Author Stephen King makes a killing in twisting up our imaginations and letting our worst fears tear us apart. There is little scarier than the unknown and you feel this way every Bear market in the S&P500. When, on average, you witness up to 1/3 of your portfolio appear to disappear (only to magically reappear), it's terrifying!

Here's your salve-repeat after me, "3up, 1-down", and again, "3-up, 1-down". Approximately once every four years of the


S&P500 rising, it falls. And it's never linear, meaning it's not predictable like "up, up, up, down, up, up, up, down". If it were, I'd be writing to you from a hammock atop Peek Island in the Caribbean—and you'd be reading atop yours!

There you go, as the rapper said, "...if you don't know, now you know". If you know to expect a Bear market—even if you don't know which new apocalypse-du-jour will bring it about—it is less fear-inducing, and you can prepare. It's not a cure, yet Bear markets are as common as dirt and should be welcomed. You should know that.

If that last comment concerns you, please work on your understanding of Bear markets; why they're as necessary as a prescribed burning for a forest, and how to take advantage of them with elegant investment technique. Make sure you have this conversation with a friend you can trust, someone professionally qualified.

Which leads me to the gap between you and the media you consume. The media is not qualified to counsel you. I once heard a former CNBC producer at a financial planning conference share that they produce to induce maximum fear and greed in 15-minute increments. Why? For advertising revenue! The financial media plays with both sides of your brain to keep you glued to ads, not your well-being.

Imagine if the financial media messaged, "spend less than you make, define your goals, fund your goals, be disciplined, this too shall pass"—they'd have no advertising revenue! No, they believe you're ignorant, that you'll imbibe whatever they throw at you (if they throw enough of it), and they'll

entertain you with green and red lights, and Cramer honks and horns, until you surrender. You're better than that.

So, how do you protect yourself from the media? First, you turn it off! Swap that media time for the family, exercise, or hobby time that you've been neglecting. When you next consume your media, just imagine those Harry Potter creatures sucking your life force out of your ears and eyeballs—Dementors, that's what they're called!

For your second step, what if I told you

that working with a qualified financial advisor could make you an excess 3.1% per year in return than you can get on your ownwould you believe me? Well, please don't as I'd never suggest such a precise figure. Instead, believe John Bogle's Vanguard, they spent millions of dollars on research to evidence it and they did. Google The Advisor's Alpha.

Now, some of you are bottom-liners like me, so let's restate more succinctly and not get carried away with "3% per year." Here we go: hire the right financial advisor and you will do better than you could on your own net of advisor cost. We have lots of great financial advisors here in the affluent area of Carlsbad, so take your pick!

Lastly, and we've run out of time, I'd like you to write down the numbers 12, 10, 6 and 3. Next time we're going to talk about what I call your "margin of safety" and I'll explain the figures—your financial fate depends on them. For now, I'll leave you with a visual, a couple questions, and then hopefully make you squirm ala Stephen King.

If a Tsunami was guaranteed to hit the 7.5 miles of Carlsbad coastline within hours of your reading this, and wipe out most everything within the first low-lying two miles of land, would you A) increase your margin of safety—get away from the coast? Or B) decrease your margin of safety—move toward the coast?

Easy to answer when it comes to a fictional Tsunami, right? Here's the rub-most of you reading this are in fact lined up on a financial cliff-edge where a real Tsunami is about to hit, and you are oh so blissfully unaware.

Stroke: Treatable and preventable

A stroke most often occurs due to a blockage or rupture in a blood vessel in the brain. According to the American Stroke Association, an ischemic stroke is caused by a clot that is blocking the blood supply to the brain. A hemorrhagic stroke takes place because of bleeding, whether it be from the brain tissue or an aneurysm – when the walls of the blood vessel balloon and then rupture.

"There are subtle differences in the B.E.F.A.ST. warning signs and symptoms that manifest with each type of stroke," said Arthur Omuro, DO, a board-certified vascular neurologist and neurohospitalist and Stroke Director at **Tri-City Medical Center** (TCMC). "For example, a severe, sudden-onset headache often described as a 'thunderclap' is more common with a hemorrhagic stroke, while being exceedingly rare in ischemic strokes. When patients come to the Emergency Room (ER) with any of these symptoms, it can be difficult to differentiate the type of stroke until they have a CT scan. Once we know, we can determine how best to treat it"

Tri-City was the first hospital in North County to earn the Thrombectomy-Capable Stroke Center certification from The Joint Commission, in collaboration with the American Heart Association/American Stroke Association. This means the hospital has met rigorous standards for performing and caring after endovascular thrombectomy, a specialized interventional procedure that can save lives by removing blood clots from the brain during an ischemic stroke.

"The medications or surgical options for treating a hemorrhagic stroke depend on the location and amount of bleeding," said Dr. Omuro. "Our goal is to prevent further bleeding, reduce pressure on the brain and provide supportive care to prevent neuro-

logic deterioration so patients have the best chance for recovery."

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reports that every year, about 800,000 people in the US have a stroke and about 1 out of 4 are recurrent strokes. "Determining the cause of a stroke may help to prevent future strokes," said Dr. Omuro. "This starts with regular visits to a primary care physician and other stroke care doctors to identify and continually monitor common risk factors such as high blood pressure, high cholesterol, obesity, diabetes and heart disease. Age, family history, race and gender must be factored in as well.

"I encourage patients to work with their

health team, know the B.E.F.A.ST. warning signs and read the American Stroke Association's 2021 Guideline for the Prevention of Stroke to learn more."


