Reimagining workforce development

The role of Community **Colleges in building** the future workforce



Community colleges are essential drivers of economic mobility, providing accessible education and career pathways that meet the needs of both students and employers. As technology transforms industries, workforce development

must adapt. At MiraCosta College, we take a "Futures" approach—preparing students for tomorrow's jobs while addressing workforce gaps, particularly in underserved com-

MiraCosta College has secured over \$7.8 million in grants to expand apprenticeship programs in high-demand fields, focusing on underrepresented groups. This includes a \$1.5 million grant to launch IT apprenticeship programs in digital marketing, software development, IT helpdesk, data analysis, and cybersecurity. In partnership with Open-Classrooms, we aim to place 150 apprentices over three years, offering fully online, competency-based education with expert mentors. These efforts address the 7,338 new IT jobs projected in Oceanside by 2028.

A \$1.5 million Digital Marketing Apprenticeship Program grant provides additional training for market research analysts, opening pathways to high-wage jobs across San Diego County. Collaborating with Clear Digital Labs, this initiative offers mentoring, credentialing, and job placement support, while another \$4.1 million supports those seeking life science and biotech careers.

Apprenticeships, supported by strong industry partnerships, are crucial for aligning education with labor market demands. Ac-

MiraCosta College's workforce development efforts align skills with employer needs, preparing graduates for high-demand IT, biomanufacturing, and healthcare jobs. By strengthening partnerships with industry leaders, we bridge the gap between employer needs and workforce capabilities, addressing labor shortages and supporting regional economic growth.

MiraCosta has also secured a \$120,000 grant to plan a noncredit pharmacy technician apprenticeship in partnership with CVS and the LAUNCH network. A \$500,000 pre-apprenticeship grant supports biomanufacturing training in clinical laboratory sciences, contributing to California's goal of developing 500,000 apprentices by 2029. This program builds infrastructure for clinical laboratory technologist training, creating innovative pathways to employment in the healthcare sector.

The Bioscience Workforce Development Hub at MiraCosta College is at the core of these efforts. This Hub aligns our training programs with the bioscience industry's needs and provides experiential learning opportunities. We're building a talent pipeline ready to contribute to the bioscience industry by collaborating with 40 bioscience programs across California, dual enrollment, and articulated high school programs. These efforts help students succeed and strengthen California's broader economy.

teacher Carol King's Virtual Enterprise (VE) classes have already decided on the types of businesses their classmates will start. Now a group students seeking the positions of CEO, COO, or CFO of these virtual businesses are un-

dergoing interviews by volunteers from the Carlsbad business community and by student graduates of the program. The simulated real-world job interviews help prepare the students for their future careers.

For example, Matt applied to be hired as CEO for a proposed business called Lumina Al. "We envision a business that teaches the public how to use AI efficiently, effectively, and ethically, and how to control AI so that it doesn't do the things you don't want it to do," said Matt. "I would love to be an entrepreneur. I am interested in finance, management, and writing." Matt, who attended a summer program at Stanford, also participates in speech and debate and cross-country - so the CEO job would require him to

exercise excellent time management skills.

Ava, likewise, is interested in taking on the role of COO and managing all the departments. An organized leader, she runs the Robo Puffs, a Business League robotics team. She also has amassed database experience, and knows how to keep her team on task through effective communication.

Colton, from Utah, enjoys the outdoors. He wants to start a construction business in the future. He is excited about marketing, through posters and TikTok, a product that doesn't exist yet. He has learned some QuickBooks and has earned a certification in

Other students show similar enthusiasm. Preston is applying to be a CFO because he's interested in finance. Samuel wants to be a COO because he likes working with people and is looking forward to the fast pace of operations at Lumina Al.

Victoria would like to be the CEO of Outside, a company with an app that encourages young people to get more exercise. And Robert would like to be a CEO or VP of marketing. "I know what it is to be a leader

by watching my role models on the football team and observing how they motivate people," he says. "They listen to everyone. Anyone can have a good idea or a bad idea."

Once the leaders are selected, the whole class gets to work creating their businesses. Students take on tasks in marketing, financials, IT, sales, and HR. They hone their product, build their marketing plans and budgets, and devise their elevator pitches. They are excited about what they are learning.

Throughout the school year students will gain entrepreneurial, hands-on experience managing and operating their virtual companies. They will practice job interviewing and résumé building; and they will learn, while "on the job," the roles of CEOs and CFOs. Students even learn to take a look at their online presence-which do they see, SnapChat or LinkedIn? And, in the spring, the CHS students will compete with students across the state at a VE Trade Show competition in Bakersfield.

Local businessman Aaron Byzak, chief strategist for Galvanized Strategies and a board member of the Carlsbad Chamber of Commerce, volunteered to conduct some of the job interviews. He says, "These high school kids are rocking it. They show up for their interviews dressed appropriately. They ask for input and suggestions. They have good resumes-they have already accomplished a lot. I see an interesting mix of success in athletics and academics. They're

LA COSTA



Leucadia Pizza is on Tamarack Ave. Great pizza. We have had this for many workshops and office meetings.


CARLSBAD ADJACENT
